Today's Message

“Have No Fear, 2”

Scripture text: Luke 12:1-12

In Luke 12, Luke recorded **five warnings** from our Lord. **Four of these warnings must be heeded by God's people today** if we are to be faithful disciples; and **the fifth warning should be heeded by a lost world.**

Beware of Hypocrisy

Beware of Covetousness

Beware of Worrying

Beware of Carelessness

Beware of Spiritual Dullness

Sir Walter Scott wrote:

O what a tangled web we weave
When first we practice to deceive.

Hypocrisy is foolish and futile (vv. 2–3).

Why? Because nothing can really be hidden.

Jesus referred here primarily to His own teachings, but the principle applies to other areas of life. **The Twelve might be tempted to cover or compromise the truth** so that neither the crowds nor the Pharisees **would be offended** (see Luke 8:16–18; 11:33).

Luke 8:16-18 "No one after lighting a lamp covers it with a jar or puts it under a bed, but puts it on a stand, so **that those who enter may see the light. For nothing is hidden that will not be made manifest, nor is anything secret that will not be known and come to light.** Take care then how you hear, for to the one who has, more will be given, and from the one who has not, **even what he thinks that he has will be taken away.**"

Luke 11:33 "No one after lighting a lamp puts it in a cellar or under a basket, but on a stand, so **that those who enter may see the light.**

Hosea 4:6-9 My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge; because **you have rejected knowledge, I reject you** from being a priest to me. And since you have **forgotten the law of your God**, I also will forget your children. The more they increased, **the more they sinned against me**; I will change their glory into shame. They feed on the sin of my people; they are greedy for their iniquity. And it shall be like people, like priest; **I will punish them for their ways and repay them for their deeds.**

This can be the priest rejecting God or the people rejecting God's messenger.

God's truth is like light, not leaven, and it must not be hidden.

The lies of the hypocrite will one day be revealed, so why go on pretending? **Let your light shine!**

We must understand what causes hypocrisy (vv. 4–7).

Jesus mentioned “**fear**” five times in these verses, so He is teaching us **that a basic cause of hypocrisy is the fear of man. When we are afraid of what others may say about us or do to us, then we try to impress them in order to gain their approval.**
