**Today's Message**

**“Courage and Valor”**

**Scripture text: Joshua 1:1-9**

**Joshua 1:6-9** **Be strong and courageous**, for you shall cause this people to inherit the land that I swore to their fathers to give them. Only **be strong and very courageous**, being careful to do according to all the law that Moses my servant commanded you. Do not turn from it to the right hand or to the left, that you may have good success wherever you go. This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success. Have I not commanded you? **Be strong and courageous. Do not be frightened, and do not be dismayed**, for the LORD your God is with you wherever you go."

**Genesis 14:14-16** When Abram heard that his kinsman had been taken captive, he led forth his **trained men**, born in his house, **318 of them**, and **went in pursuit** as far as Dan. And he divided his forces against them by night, **he and his servants**, and **defeated them and pursued them to Hobah**, north of Damascus. Then he brought back all the possessions, and also brought back his kinsman Lot with his possessions, and the women and the people.

- 1. He is his brother's keeper**
- 2. He trained his men to fight, men of valor**
- 3. He prepped with provisions to go after those who captured his nephew.**

**Genesis 4:6-10** The LORD said to Cain, "Why are you angry, and why has your face fallen? If you do well, will you not be accepted? And if you do not do well, sin is crouching at the door. Its desire is for you, but you must rule over it." Cain spoke to Abel his brother. And when they were in the field, Cain rose up against his brother Abel and killed him. Then the LORD said to Cain, "**Where is Abel your brother?**" He said, "I do not know; **am I my brother's keeper?**" And the LORD said, "**What have you done? The voice of your brother's blood is crying to me from the ground.**"

**You are your brother's keeper! Remember, love your neighbor as yourself!**

**Psalm 144:1-2** Of David. Blessed be the LORD, my rock, who trains my hands for war, and my fingers for battle; he is my steadfast love and my fortress, my stronghold and my deliverer, my shield and he in whom I take refuge, who subdues peoples under me.

**2 Samuel 22:33-36** This God is my strong refuge and has made my way blameless. He made my feet like the feet of a deer and set me secure on the heights. He trains my hands for war, so that my arms can bend a bow of bronze. You have given me the shield of your salvation, and your gentleness made me great.



**Nehemiah 4:11-14** And our enemies said, "They will not know or see **till we come among them and kill them and stop the work.**" At that time the Jews who lived near them came from all directions and said to us ten times, "You must return to us." So in the lowest parts of the space behind the wall, in open places, I **stationed the people by their clans, with their swords, their spears, and their bows.** And I looked and arose and said to the nobles and to the officials and to the rest of the people, "**Do not be afraid of them. Remember the Lord, who is great and awesome, and fight for your brothers, your sons, your daughters, your wives, and your homes.**"

**Ephesians 6:10-14a** Finally, **be strong in the Lord and in the strength of his might.** Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able **to stand against the schemes of the devil.** For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers over this present darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places. Therefore take up the whole armor of God, **that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand firm. Stand therefore,**

What does it mean to stand firm?

**Ezekiel 14:13-16** "Son of man, **when a land sins against me by acting faithlessly**, and I stretch out my hand against it and **break its supply of bread and send famine upon it**, and cut off from it man and beast, even if these three men, **Noah, Daniel, and Job**, were in it, they would deliver but their own lives by their righteousness, declares the Lord GOD. "**If I cause wild beasts to pass through the land, and they ravage it, and it be made desolate**, so that no one may pass through because of the beasts, even if these three men were in it, as I live, declares the Lord GOD, **they would deliver neither sons nor daughters**. They alone would be delivered, but the land would be desolate.
