“It Was Foretold”

Scripture text: Luke 21:1-38

Luke 21:8-13 And he said, "**See that you are not led astray.** For many will come in my name, saying, 'I am he!' and, 'The time is at hand!' Do not go after them. And when **you hear of wars and tumults, do not be terrified,** for these things must first take place, but the end will not be at once." Then he said to them, "Nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom. There will be great earthquakes, and in various places famines and pestilences. And **there will be terrors and great signs from heaven.** But before all this they will lay their hands on you and persecute you, delivering you up to the synagogues and prisons, and you will be brought before kings and governors for my name's sake. **This will be your opportunity to bear witness.**

Anxiety, Depression, and Suicide is at a all time high here in America.

Why?

All that is happening now, was foretold in the Bible.

Matthew 24:6 And you will hear of wars and rumors of wars. **See that you are not alarmed, for this must take place**, but the end is not yet.

John 10:10 The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have life and have it abundantly.

Revelation 6:9-11 When he opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of those who had been slain for the word of God and for the witness they had borne. They cried out with a loud voice, "O Sovereign Lord, holy and true, how long before you will judge and avenge our blood on those who dwell on the earth?" Then they were each given a white robe and told to rest a little longer, until the number of their fellow servants and their brothers should be complete, who were to be killed as they themselves had been.

Romans 1:28-32 And since they did not see fit to acknowledge God, God gave them up to a debased mind to do what ought not to be done. They were filled with all manner of unrighteousness, evil, covetousness, malice. They are full of envy, murder, strife, deceit, maliciousness. They are gossips, slanderers, haters of God, insolent, haughty, boastful, inventors of evil, disobedient to parents, foolish, faithless, heartless, ruthless. **Though they know God's decree that those who practice such things deserve to die, they not only do them but give approval to those who practice them.**

Psalm 42:2-6 My soul thirsts for God, for the living God. When shall I come and appear before God? **My tears have been my food day and night**, while they say to me all the day long, "Where is your God?" These things I remember, **as I pour out my soul**: how I would go with the throng and lead them in procession to the house of God with glad shouts and songs of praise, a multitude keeping festival. **Why are you cast down, O my soul, and why are you in turmoil within me? Hope in God; for I shall again praise him, my salvation and my God. My soul is cast down within me; therefore I remember you from the land of Jordan and of Hermon, from Mount Mizar.**

ANXIETY. Various degrees of anxiety, ranging from concern to fear and dread, are depicted in both the Old and New Testaments.

Anxiety may be the natural concern a parent exhibits for his children (1 Sam. 9:5; 10:2) or that which one feels for the well-being of a fellow (Phil. 2:20). It includes personal distress such as that caused by Hannah's barrenness (1 Sam. 1:16) or Daniel's dream (Dan. 7:15), as well as the fear and trembling precipitated by war (cf. 1 Chr. 17:9) or natural disaster (Jer. 17:8). The Psalms give frequent expression to such feelings (Ps. 127:2; cf. 102:7; Prov. 12:25).

Psalm 127:2 It is in vain that you rise up early and go late to rest, eating the bread of **anxious toil**; for he gives to his beloved sleep.

Proverb 12:25 **Anxiety in a man's heart weighs him down**, but a good word makes him glad.

Psalm 102:7-11 I lie **awake**; I am like a **lonely** sparrow on the housetop. All the day my enemies taunt me; those who deride me **use my name for a curse**. For I eat ashes like bread and mingle tears with my drink, because of your indignation and anger; for you have taken me up and thrown me down. My days are like an evening shadow; I wither away like grass.

While loving concern may be constructive (**2 Cor. 11:28** *And, apart from other things, there is the daily pressure on me of **my anxiety** for all the churches.*),

Jesus cautions that unnecessary attention to physical needs or the “**cares of the world**” may hinder the life of faith and the Christian’s participation in the kingdom of God.

Matthew 13:22 As for what was sown among thorns, this is the one who hears the word, **but the cares of the world and the deceitfulness of riches choke the word**, and it proves unfruitful.

Mark 4:18-19 And others are the ones sown **among thorns**. They are those who hear the word, **but the cares of the world and the deceitfulness of riches and the desires for other things** enter in and choke the word, and it proves unfruitful.

Luke 8:14 And as for what fell **among the thorns**, they are those who hear, but as they go on their way **they are choked by the cares and riches and pleasures of life**, and their fruit does not mature.

Luke 12:22-23 And he said to his disciples, "Therefore I tell you, **do not be anxious about your life**, what you will eat, nor about your body, what you will put on. **For life is more than food, and the body more than clothing.**

Luke 12:29-32 And do not seek what you are to eat and what you are to drink, **nor be worried**. For all the nations of the world seek after these things, and **your Father knows that you need them**. Instead, **seek his kingdom**, and **these things will be added to you**. "**Fear not**, little flock, **for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom.**

Rather, one should place his burdens on God, who protects and cares for his people.

1 Peter 5:6-10 Humble yourselves, therefore, under the mighty hand of God so that at the proper time he may exalt you, **casting all your anxieties on him, because he cares for you.** Be sober-minded; **be watchful.** Your adversary the devil prowls around like a roaring lion, **seeking someone to devour. Resist him, firm in your faith,** knowing that the same kinds of suffering are being experienced by your brotherhood throughout the world. And **after you have suffered a little while,** the God of all grace, **who has called you** to his eternal glory in Christ, **will himself restore, confirm, strengthen, and establish you.**

John 10:9-15 I am the door. If anyone enters by me, he will be saved and will go in and out and find pasture. The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have life and have it abundantly. I am the good shepherd. **The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep.** He who is a hired hand and not a shepherd, who does not own the sheep, sees the wolf coming and leaves the sheep and flees, and the wolf snatches them and scatters them. He flees because he is a hired hand and cares nothing for the sheep. **I am the good shepherd. I know my own and my own know me, just as the Father knows me and I know the Father; and I lay down my life for the sheep.**

Philippians 4:2-7 I entreat Euodia and I entreat Syntyche to agree in the Lord. Yes, I ask you also, true companion, help these women, who have labored side by side with me in the gospel together with Clement and the rest of my fellow workers, whose names are in the book of life. Rejoice in the Lord always; again I will say, Rejoice. **Let your reasonableness be known to everyone.** The Lord is at hand; do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And **the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding**, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

Psalm 23 A Psalm of David. **The LORD is my shepherd**; I shall not want. He makes me lie down in green pastures. He leads me beside still waters. He restores my soul. He leads me in paths of righteousness for his name's sake. Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, **I will fear no evil, for you are with me**; your rod and your staff, they comfort me. You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; you anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows. Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life, and **I shall dwell in the house of the LORD forever.**

Philippians 3:17-21 Brothers, join in imitating me, and keep your eyes on those who walk according to the example you have in us. For many, of whom I have often told you and now tell you even with tears, walk as enemies of the cross of Christ. Their end is destruction, their god is their belly, and they glory in their shame, with minds set on earthly things. But **our citizenship is in heaven, and from it we await a Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ, who will transform our lowly body to be like his glorious body, by the power that enables him even to subject all things to himself.**
