Psalm 10:1-6 Why, O LORD, do you stand far away? Why do you hide yourself in times of trouble? In arrogance the wicked hotly pursue the poor; **let them be caught in the schemes that they have devised.** For the wicked boasts of the desires of his soul, and the one greedy for gain curses and renounces the LORD. In the pride of his face the wicked does not seek him; all his thoughts are, "There is no God." **His ways prosper at all times;** your judgments are on high, out of his sight; as for all his foes, he puffs at them. **He says in his heart, "I shall not be moved; throughout all generations I shall not meet adversity."**

Psalm 10:13-18 Why does the wicked renounce God and say in his heart, "**You will not call to account**"? But you do see, for you note mischief and vexation, that you may take it into your hands; to you the helpless commits himself; you have been the helper of the fatherless. **Break the arm of the wicked and evildoer; call his wickedness to account till you find none.** The LORD is king forever and ever; the nations perish from his land. O LORD, **you hear the desire of the afflicted; you will strengthen their heart; you will incline your ear to do justice to the fatherless and the oppressed, so that man who is of the earth may strike terror no more.**

1 John 2:1-6 My little children, I am writing these things to you so that you may not sin. But if anyone does sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous. He is the propitiation for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the sins of the whole world. And by this we know that we have come to know him, if we keep his commandments. Whoever says "I know him" but does not keep his commandments is a liar, and the truth is not in him, but whoever keeps his word, in him truly the love of God is perfected. By this we may know that we are in him: whoever says he abides in him ought to walk in the same way in which he walked.

Matthew 3:13-17 Then Jesus came from Galilee to the Jordan to John, **to be baptized by him.** John would have prevented him, saying, "I need to be baptized by you, and do you come to me?" But Jesus answered him, "**Let it be so now, for thus it is fitting for us to fulfill all righteousness.**" Then he consented. **And when Jesus was baptized, immediately he went up from the water, and behold, the heavens were opened to him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and coming to rest on him; and behold, a voice from heaven said, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased."**

Matthew 4:13-17 And leaving Nazareth he went and lived in Capernaum by the sea, in the territory of Zebulun and Naphtali, so that what was spoken by the prophet Isaiah might be fulfilled: "The land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali, the way of the sea, beyond the Jordan, Galilee of the Gentiles-- **the people dwelling in darkness have seen a great light, and for those dwelling in the region and shadow of death, on them a light has dawned.**" From that time **Jesus began to preach, saying, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand."**

Matthew 10:24 -28 "A disciple is not above his teacher, nor a servant above his master. **It is enough for the disciple to be like his teacher, and the servant like his master.** If they have called the master of the house Beelzebul, **how much more will they malign those of his household.** "So have no fear of them, for nothing is covered that will not be revealed, or hidden that will not be known. **What I tell you in the dark, say in the light, and what you hear whispered, proclaim on the housetops.** And do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. Rather **fear him who can destroy both soul and body in hell.**

Matthew 11:27-30 All things have been handed over to me by my Father, and no one knows the Son except the Father, and no one knows the Father except the Son and **anyone to whom the Son chooses to reveal him.** Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I **will give you rest.** Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light."

John 15:4-8 Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit by itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, **unless you abide in me.** I am the vine; you are the branches. **Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing.** If anyone does not abide in me he is thrown away like a branch and withers; and the branches are gathered, thrown into the fire, and burned. **If you abide in me, and my words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you. By this my Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit and so prove to be my disciples.**

1 John 2:4 Whoever says "I know him" but does not keep his commandments is a liar, and the truth is not in him,

John 17:15-19 I do not ask that you take them out of the world, **but that you keep them from the evil one.** They are not of the world, just as I am not of the world. **Sanctify them in the truth; your word is truth.** As you sent me into the world, **so I have sent them into the world.** And for their sake I consecrate myself, **that they also may be sanctified in truth.**

John 8:31-32 So Jesus said to the Jews who had believed in him, "**If you abide in my word, you are truly my disciples, and you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free.**"

Romans 8:31-34 What then shall we say to these things? **If God is for us, who can be against us?** He who did not spare his own Son but gave him up for us all, how will he not also with him graciously give us all things? **Who shall bring any charge against God's elect? It is God who justifies. Who is to condemn?** Christ Jesus is the one who died--more than that, who was raised--**who is at the right hand of God, who indeed is interceding for us.**

Romans 8:35-39 Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or danger, or sword? As it is written, "For your sake we are being killed all the day long; we are regarded as sheep to be slaughtered." **No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. For I am sure** that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, nor height nor depth, **nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord.**
