Today's Message

“Jesus Came to Save”

Scripture text: John 12:44-50

John 12:44-49 And Jesus cried out and said, "Whoever believes in me, believes not in me but in him who sent me. And whoever sees me sees him who sent me. **I have come into the world as light, so that whoever believes in me may not remain in darkness.** If anyone hears my words and does not keep them, **I do not judge him; for I did not come to judge the world but to save the world.** The one who rejects me and does not receive my words has a judge; **the word that I have spoken will judge him on the last day.** For **I have not spoken on my own authority,** but the Father who sent me has himself given me a commandment--**what to say and what to speak.**

John 12:44 And Jesus cried out and said, "**Whoever believes in me, believes not in me but in him who sent me.**

Isaiah 55:1-3 "**Come**, everyone who thirsts, come to the waters; and he who has no money, come, buy and eat! **Come**, buy wine and milk without money and without price. Why do you spend your money for that which is not bread, and your labor for that which does not satisfy? **Listen diligently to me**, and eat what is good, and delight yourselves in rich food. **Incline your ear, and come to me; hear, that your soul may live;** and I will make with you an everlasting covenant, my steadfast, sure love for David.

John 13:16-20 Truly, truly, I say to you, a servant is not greater than his master, nor is a messenger greater than the one who sent him. **If you know these things, blessed are you if you do them.** I am not speaking of all of you; **I know whom I have chosen.** But the Scripture will be fulfilled, 'He who ate my bread has lifted his heel against me.' **I am telling you this now,** before it takes place, that when it does take place you may believe that I am he. **Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever receives the one I send receives me, and whoever receives me receives the one who sent me."**

Matthew 10:38-42 And **whoever does not take his cross and follow me is not worthy of me.** Whoever finds his life will lose it, and **whoever loses his life for my sake will find it.** "Whoever receives you receives me, and **whoever receives me receives him who sent me.** The one who receives a prophet because he is a prophet will receive a prophet's reward, and the one who receives a righteous person because he is a righteous person will receive a righteous person's reward. And whoever gives one of these little ones even a cup of cold water because he is a disciple, truly, I say to you, **he will by no means lose his reward."**

Proverb 1:20-26 Wisdom cries aloud in the street, in the markets she raises her voice; at the head of the noisy streets she cries out; at the entrance of the city gates she speaks: "**How long, O simple ones, will you love being simple? How long will scoffers delight in their scoffing and fools hate knowledge?** If you turn at my reproof, behold, **I will pour out my spirit to you; I will make my words known to you.** Because I have called and you refused to listen, have stretched out my hand and no one has heeded, **because you have ignored all my counsel and would have none of my reproof, I also will laugh at your calamity; I will mock when terror strikes you,**

Proverb 1:27-33 when terror strikes you like a storm and your calamity comes like a whirlwind, when distress and anguish come upon you. **Then they will call upon me, but I will not answer; they will seek me diligently but will not find me. Because they hated knowledge and did not choose the fear of the LORD, would have none of my counsel and **despised all my reproof, therefore they shall eat the fruit of their way, and have their fill of their own devices.** For the simple are killed by their turning away, and the **complacency of fools destroys them; but whoever listens to me will dwell secure and will be at ease, without dread of disaster.**"**

Matthew 5:13-16 "You are the salt of the earth, but if salt has lost its taste, how shall its saltiness be restored? It is no longer good for anything except to be thrown out and trampled under people's feet. "You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden. Nor do people light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a stand, and it gives light to all in the house. **In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven.**

John 12:45 And **whoever sees me sees him who sent me.**

John 14:9-10 Jesus said to him, "Have I been with you so long, and you still do not know me, Philip? Whoever has seen me has seen the Father. How can you say, 'Show us the Father'? **Do you not believe that I am in the Father and the Father is in me?** The words that I say to you I do not speak on my own authority, but **the Father who dwells in me does his works.**

John 15:21-25 But all these things they will do to you on account of my name, **because they do not know him who sent me.** If I had not come and spoken to them, they would not have been guilty of sin, but **now they have no excuse for their sin. Whoever hates me hates my Father also.** If I had not done among them the works that no one else did, they would not be guilty of sin, but **now they have seen and hated both me and my Father.** But the word that is written in their Law must be fulfilled: 'They hated me without a cause.'

1 John 5:17-21 All wrongdoing is sin, but there is sin that does not lead to death. **We know that everyone who has been born of God does not keep on sinning, but he who was born of God protects him, and the evil one does not touch him.** We know that we are from God, and the whole world lies in the power of the evil one. And we know that **the Son of God has come and has given us understanding, so that we may know him who is true;** and we are in him who is true, in his Son Jesus Christ. **He is the true God and eternal life.** Little children, keep yourselves from idols.

John 12:46 I have come into the world as light, so that whoever believes in me may not remain in darkness.

1 John 1:1-3 That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we looked upon and have touched with our hands, concerning the word of life-- **the life was made manifest, and we have seen it, and testify to it and proclaim to you the eternal life, which was with the Father and was made manifest to us--** that which we have seen and heard **we proclaim also to you,** so that you too may have fellowship with us; and **indeed our fellowship is with the Father and with his Son Jesus Christ.**

John 12:47-48 If anyone hears my words and does not keep them, I do not judge him; for I did not come to judge the world but to save the world. **The one who rejects me and does not receive my words has a judge; the word that I have spoken will judge him on the last day.**

Hebrews 2:2-3 For since the message declared by angels **proved to be reliable**, and every transgression or disobedience received a just retribution, **how shall we escape if we neglect such a great salvation?** It was declared at first by the Lord, and it was attested to us by those who heard,

2 Corinthians 2:14-17 But thanks be to God, who in Christ always leads us in triumphal procession, and **through us spreads the fragrance of the knowledge of him everywhere.** For we are **the aroma of Christ to God among those who are being saved** and among those who are perishing, to one a fragrance from death to death, to the other **a fragrance from life to life.** Who is sufficient for these things? For we are not, like so many, peddlers of God's word, but as men of sincerity, as commissioned by God, **in the sight of God we speak in Christ.**

2 Thessalonians 1:5-9 This is evidence of the righteous judgment of God, that you may be considered worthy of the kingdom of God, for which you are also suffering-- since indeed God considers it just to repay with affliction those who afflict you, and to grant relief to you who are afflicted as well as to us, when the Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven with his mighty angels in flaming fire, **inflicting vengeance on those who do not know God and on those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus.** They will suffer the punishment of eternal destruction, away from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of his might,

John 3:17-21 For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but **in order that the world might be saved through him**. Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but **whoever does not believe is condemned already**, because he has not believed in the name of the only Son of God. **And this is the judgment: the light has come into the world, and people loved the darkness rather than the light because their works were evil**. For everyone **who does wicked things hates the light** and does not come to the light, lest his works should be exposed. But **whoever does what is true comes to the light, so that it may be clearly seen that his works have been carried out in God.**"
